8 If we say we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us. 9 If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

SIN


"My sin is no big deal"

The other ways make Jesus out to be a liar - which the is not.

But if anyone does sin, we have an advocate with the Father, Jesus Christ the righteous.

WHAT GIVES JESUS THE AUTHORITY TO BE OUR ADVOCATE? <sup>2</sup>He is the propitiation for our sins, and not for ours only but also for the sins of the whole world.

Propitiation: Satisfy the Wrath of God.
God's Holiness demands Justice, that
Justice demands an outpouring of
His Wrath on Sin. Jesus satisfied
that requirement.

Whole World: The whole world as world, not the whole world as in every living person. If that were true there would be no need of the command to repent and believe the Gospel.
